4. Data Retention

Your data will be retained for as long as necessary for the purposes stated or as required by legal obligations.

5. Your Rights

As per GDPR, you have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. You can also object to or limit the processing of your data.

6. Consent

By joining Darlington cycling club, you give consent to the collection and use of your personal data in accordance with this notice.
